



Policy for quality assurance of the educational program of the specialty "Nursing care"

Dean's office of the faculty of Public Health, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing care, Medical and Preventive care is responsible for the professional training of competitive personnel in the specialty "Nursing care".

The main goals and obligations of the dean's office are to organize the educational process, to control, to analyze and to monitor students' academic performances, to coordinate the educational, methodological, scientific and clinical activities of chairs.

The main directions and principles of the quality assurance policy:

1. Modernization of the educational process:

- development of new educational forms, programs and standards;
- development and implementation of new educational technologies and training systems;
- increasing the role of chairs as a decisive element in ensuring the quality of teaching and educational process organization;
- modernization of the content of education, consideration and satisfaction of the needs and expectations of external and internal consumers;
- ensuring the unity of education and upbringing.

2. Modernization of the research process and innovation:

- development of innovative activities;
- creation of conditions and infrastructure that contribute to the conduct of effective scientific research and promotion of their results;
- implementation of modern models of scientific and methodological support of the educational process.

3. Strengthening human resources:

- support and stimulation of professional growth of scientific and pedagogical workers;
- stimulating the creative activity of each employee and students and increasing their personal responsibility for the result of their work;
- increasing the competitiveness of the University's students in the domestic and international labor and employment markets;
- development of supporting infrastructure.

4. Improvement of the University's organizational structure and increase in the management effectiveness:

- improving the organizational structure;
- development and control of the implementation of strategic and operational plans;
- involvement of all the educational process participants: teachers, students, administrative and management personnel, into the process of ensuring effective management;
- development of corporate culture, atmosphere of trust and goodwill;



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- continuous monitoring of the performance of IMS processes according to the established indicators, results of internal and external audits, and sociological research results.

Qualification of the graduate:

Persons who passed successfully the summative assessment for the development of a professional higher education curriculum in the specialty "Nursing care" are awarded an academic degree of Bachelor of Health in the specialty "Nursing care".

Bachelor of Health in the specialty "Nursing care" may hold the following positions: chief medical nurse (deputy director for nursing, senior medical nurse (senior medical assistant, senior obstetrician, district medical officer) / medical nurse of general practice, medical nurse specialized, obstetrician, dietary nurse, etc.
