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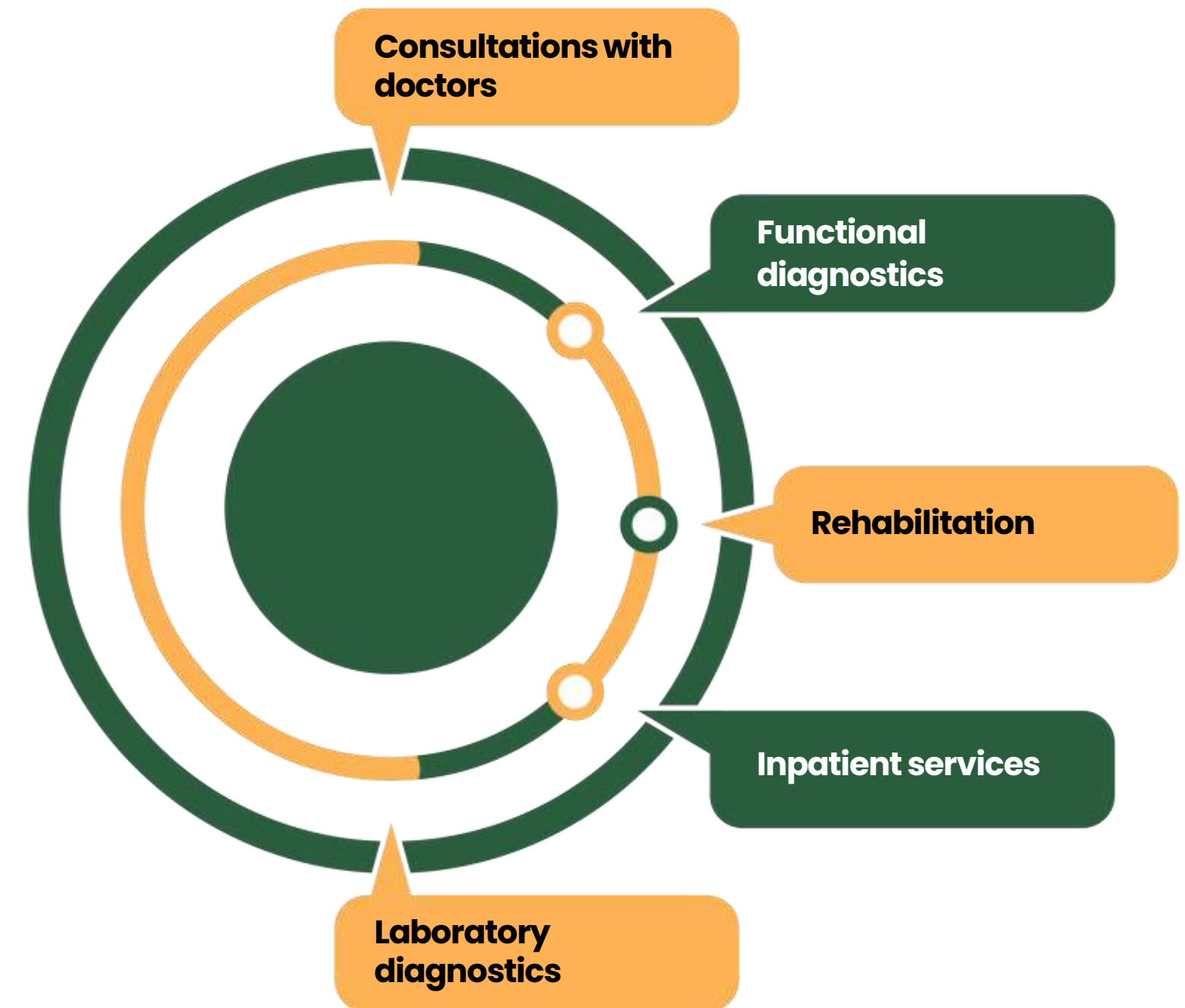

# The center currently provides a wide range of medical services, including:

The University's academic building located at 33 Saryarka Avenue houses a variety of medical services, including general practice clinics (5 units) and a pediatric office. The facility also features offices for specialized therapeutic care (cardiologist, endocrinologist, gastroenterologist, neurologist for both adults and children, phthisiatrician, dermatologist) and surgical care (surgeon, traumatologist, ophthalmologist, otolaryngologist), consultation rooms for an obstetrician-gynecologist, mammologist, oncologist, functional diagnostics rooms (ECG, ABPM, Holter monitoring, spirometry), ultrasound diagnostics room, rehabilitation department and inpatient rooms. Patients have access to modern ophthalmological equipment, ENT workstation, dental unit, equipment for physiotherapy, massage, and therapeutic exercise.



# Branches of the Medical Center

Currently, the Medical Center operates across two University campus buildings, with the main section located at 33 Saryarka Avenue.

To better serve students, a Medical Unit with consultation rooms and a treatment room has been established in the University's main building at 49 Beibitshilik Street.

In the near future, a new Medical Unit for students is planned to be opened in the University's academic building at 47 Abay Street.

Looking ahead, the goal is to consolidate all divisions of the Center into a multidisciplinary Medical Center equipped to provide highly specialized outpatient, inpatient-replacing and inpatient services.



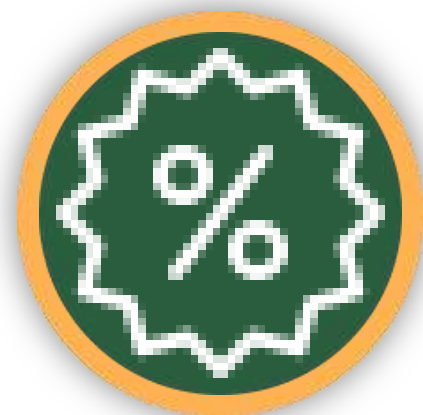

# How to Register with Our Medical Center via the "eGov mobile" app?



1. Log in to your personal account



2. Select the "Healthcare" section



3. Find the service "Registration with a Medical Organization Providing Primary Health Care"



4. Choose the district, select the medical organization "Medical Center of AMU," choose your designated area, and select "Relocation" as the reason for registration.

# REGISTRATION OF PERSONAL MEDICAL HISTORY SHEET

1

Students must individually purchase an approved standardized personal medical history sheet (MHS).

2

The personal MHS is filled out by the student in either the state or Russian language. The passport details section must include the holder's personal information as per their ID Card or passport, including occupation, job title, employer, date of birth, place of residence, personal signature, and the medical history sheet's series and number.

3

Once MHS is properly filled out, student should go to the registration desk at AMU Medical Center LLP.

- undergo identification according to their ID Card or passport.
- pay for the service.
- attach a photo to the personal MHS sealed by the Healthcare Entity of medical examination.
- a route sheet is issued at the registration desk, detailing the laboratory and diagnostic tests required, room numbers.

The X-ray (fluorography) result is attached to the MHS (image and doctor's conclusion, confirmed with seal and signature and full name specified).

Laboratory Tests Results for:  
- Pathogenic Staphylococcus carrier status;  
- Helminth Eggs;  
- Bacteriological Test and Viral Hepatitis Markers;  
- HIV-markers and Microreaction.  
are recorded by a specialist of a state sanitary-epidemiological organization confirmed with organization's seal and full name specified.

The results of doctor's examination are recorded based on the venereal disease laboratory test data and confirmed by the dermatovenerologist's seal and signature with full name specified.

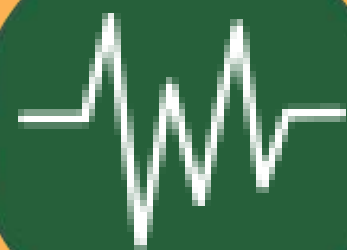
Based on all results, general medical examination conclusion is recorded by the therapist, confirmed with seal and signature and full name specified.

8

The work admission period, including the date, specialist's full name, signature, and the AMU Medical Center LLP seal is recorded in the personal MHS. The work admission is granted for 6 months or 1 year. X-ray examination results are valid for 1 year.

**Note:**

*According to Article 86, Clause 5 of the Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Public Health and Healthcare System" dated July 7, 2020, the decreed group must undergo compulsory medical examinations at their own expense or at the employer's expense by mutual agreement.*



### **Tuberculosis Prevention Measures: Fluorography Screening Algorithm**

In accordance with the Order of the Minister of Healthcare of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. ҚР ДСМ-214/2020 dated November 30, 2020 (On Approval of the Rules for Conducting Tuberculosis Prevention Measures), the following populations are required to undergo compulsory annual fluorography screenings for tuberculosis:

Paragraph 81. List of individuals subject to compulsory annual fluorography screenings:

- 1) students of higher and secondary educational institutions, vocational schools;
- 2) 15-17 years aged children;
- 3) People who have moved to Kazakhstan for permanent residence.
- 4) People who have temporarily moved to Kazakhstan, including labor migrants.



### **Cholera Prevention Measures**

According to the Resolution of the Chief Public Health Officer of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 01-1-21/388-БН dated January 29, 2021, individuals entering the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan from endemic countries, both near and far abroad, must provide the results of cholera screening tests within 10 days of entering the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to prevent and control the spread of cholera.



# Medical Certificate for Sick Leave



The AMU Medical Center doctors issue medical certificates for sick leave only from the date of the student's visit and in case of valid indications.



In case of injury, the student must visit the trauma unit at the "Multidisciplinary City Hospital No. 3" State-Owned Utility Enterprise based on the Right of Economic Management (26Б А. Moldagulova Str.) or the "Academician N.D. Batpenov National Scientific Center for Traumatology and Orthopedics" (15a Ablai Khan Ave.). Based on the traumatologist's conclusion, a certificate of temporary disability will be issued to the student.



In case of infectious diseases symptoms (e.g., ARVI, suspicion of measles, chickenpox, whooping cough, coronavirus infection, etc.), the student should visit the filter room (33 Saryarka Str.). In case of deteriorating health, call emergency medical services.



Medical certificates cannot be issued backdated (i.e., if the student skip classes due to illness and did not seek medical help during the illness).



The Medical Center issues certificates of temporary disability of 037/y form (as per Order of the Minister of Health of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. ҚР ДСМ-198/2022 dated December 18, 2022).

\* The University Medical Center does not authenticate certificates:  
for examinations conducted at other outpatient or inpatient organizations;  
for single-day sick leave from other outpatient organizations or medical centers;  
Only certificates of temporary disability from outpatient organizations where the student is officially registered are authenticated.

## For International Students

- compulsory medical insurance with the selection of AMU Medical Center LLP for the duration of studies at the University. The insurance must be provided within 10 working days from the date of entry into the Republic of Kazakhstan.

- failure to provide medical insurance will result in the student is not allowed to practical classes, with the possibility of making up missed classes on a paid basis (in accordance with the Academic Policy of AMU NCJSC dated December 8, 2023).

Certificates for class attendance issued from other Countries or Republics, or from other medical organizations, will be declined by the University.

The student must contact the responsible employee at AMU NCJSC to arrange an insurance contract with an insurance company, which will then be forwarded to the Medical Center for registration.
